# Travel Information

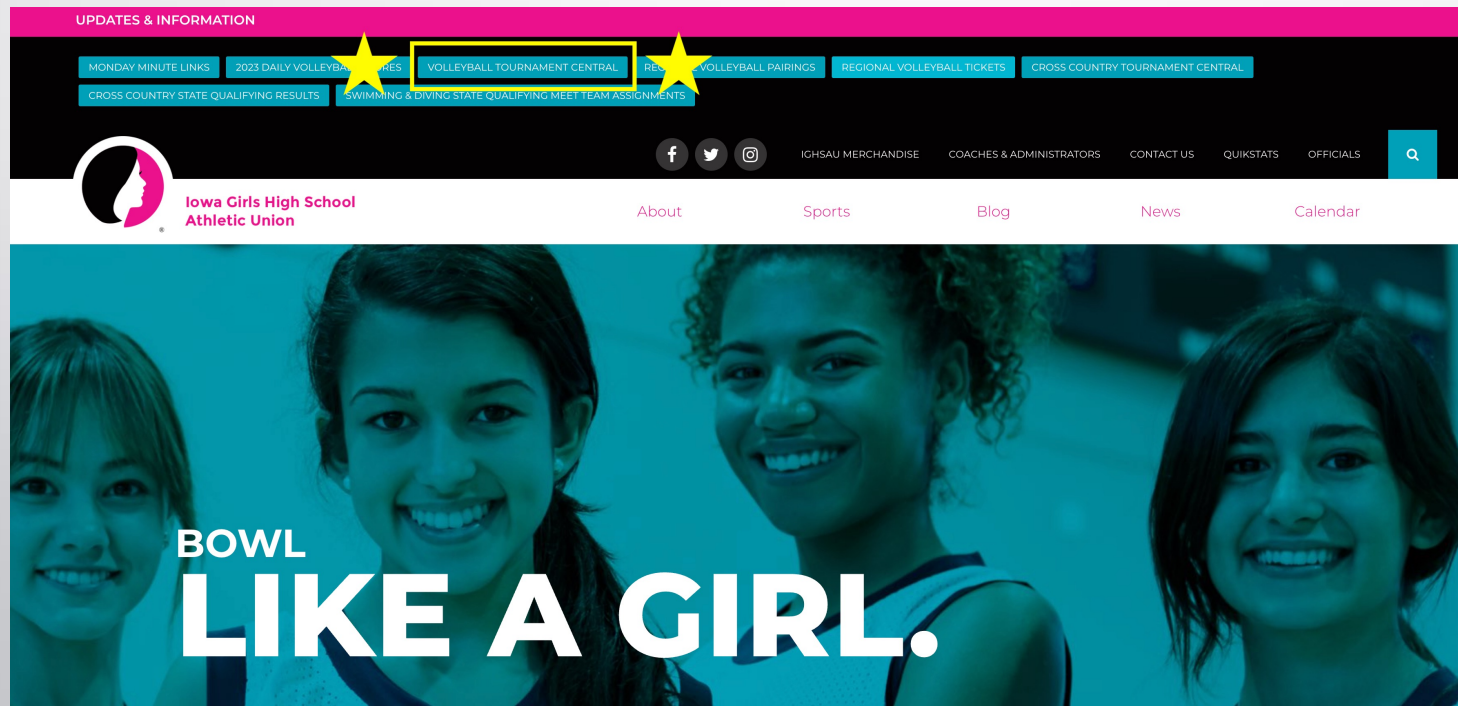
## Travel & Per Diem

- Teams less than 125 miles from Coralville – \$1.25 per mile (1 way) & \$300 food allowance each day you play.
- Teams more 125 miles from Coralville - \$1.25 per mile (1 way); \$300 food allowance & \$450 lodging allowance for each day you play.

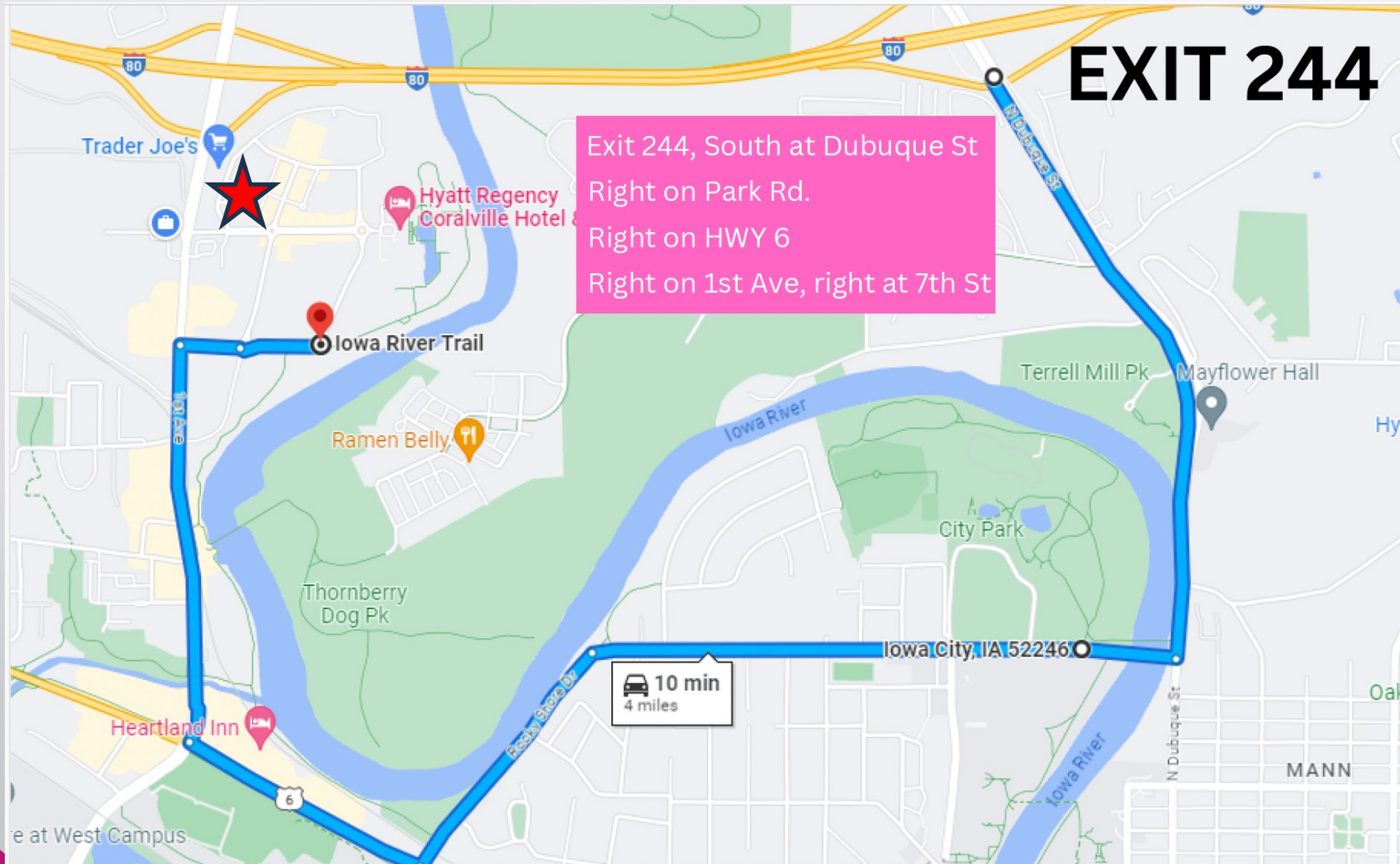

# Team Check-In / Arrival

- Green State Family Fieldhouse – Joyce Bahrke, Julie Rastetter
- Bring two (2) copies of your roster (available on Bound)
  - One copy to attendants at check-in / one copy to statisticians @ scores table
- Coaches will receive timing sheets for your match each day
- Team Check-in Gate: opens 90 minutes before first match of the day
- Team coolers – no outside food allowed
- **ADs – this is also your check-in location!!**

**Same bus offload for pep bus – must enter through spectator entrance**

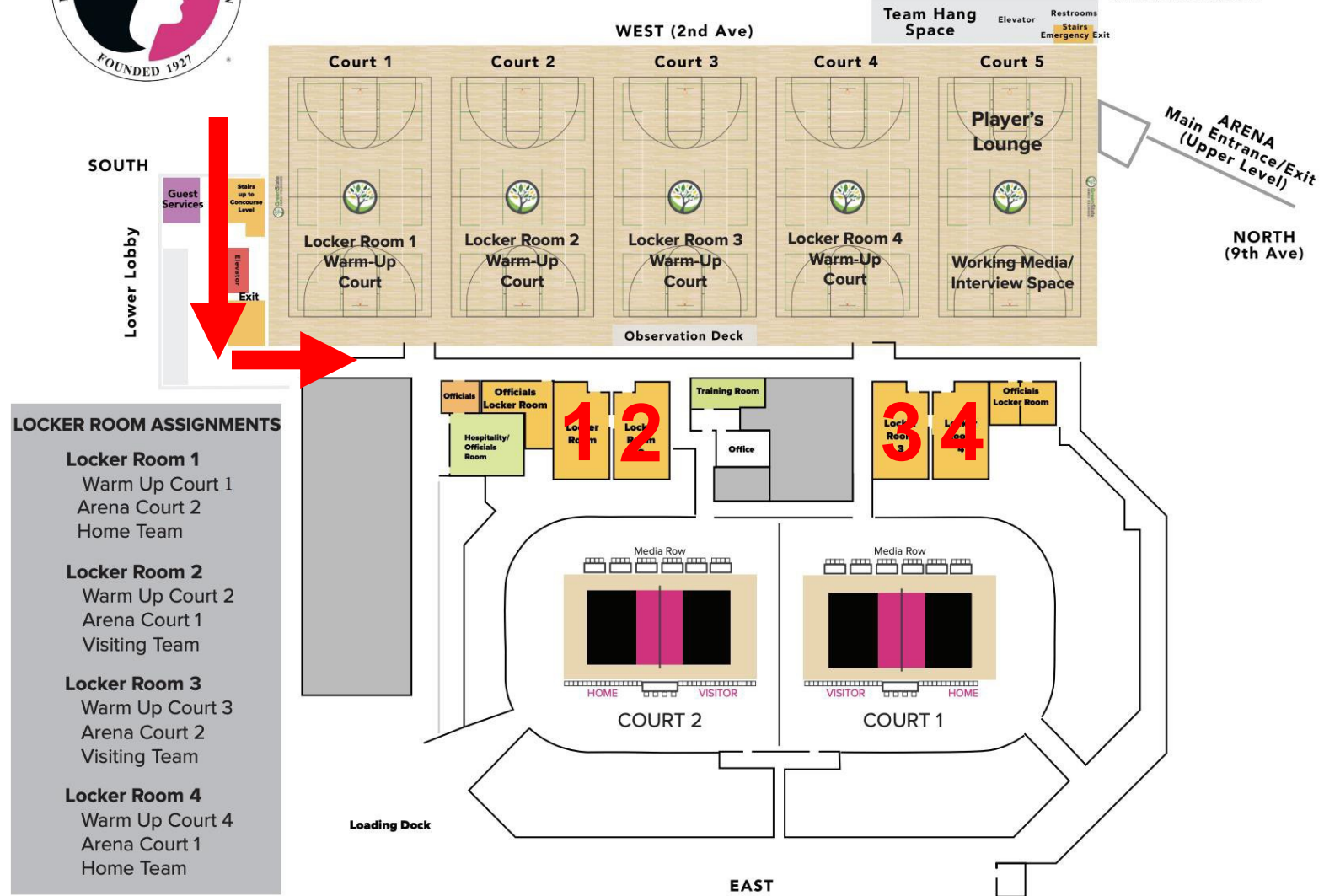
# Team Check-In / Arrival

- 23 individuals on your bench. 10 chairs. 15 uniformed players.
- Only 15 players may participate in warm-ups in the arena.
- You can be billed for any additional party members over 23. Must sit on the chairs behind the bench.
- Only **uniformed** players may stand at the end of the bench.

# Locker Rooms

- Access to your locker room **when match before yours has begun**
- Access to locker room **after** your match for 17 minutes – or until next match has begun
- If early – may drop bags in players' lounge or bleachers on assigned practice court
- Take belongings out of the locker room when you exit
- Bag Drop Areas around the arena entries
  - Drop areas will not be monitored

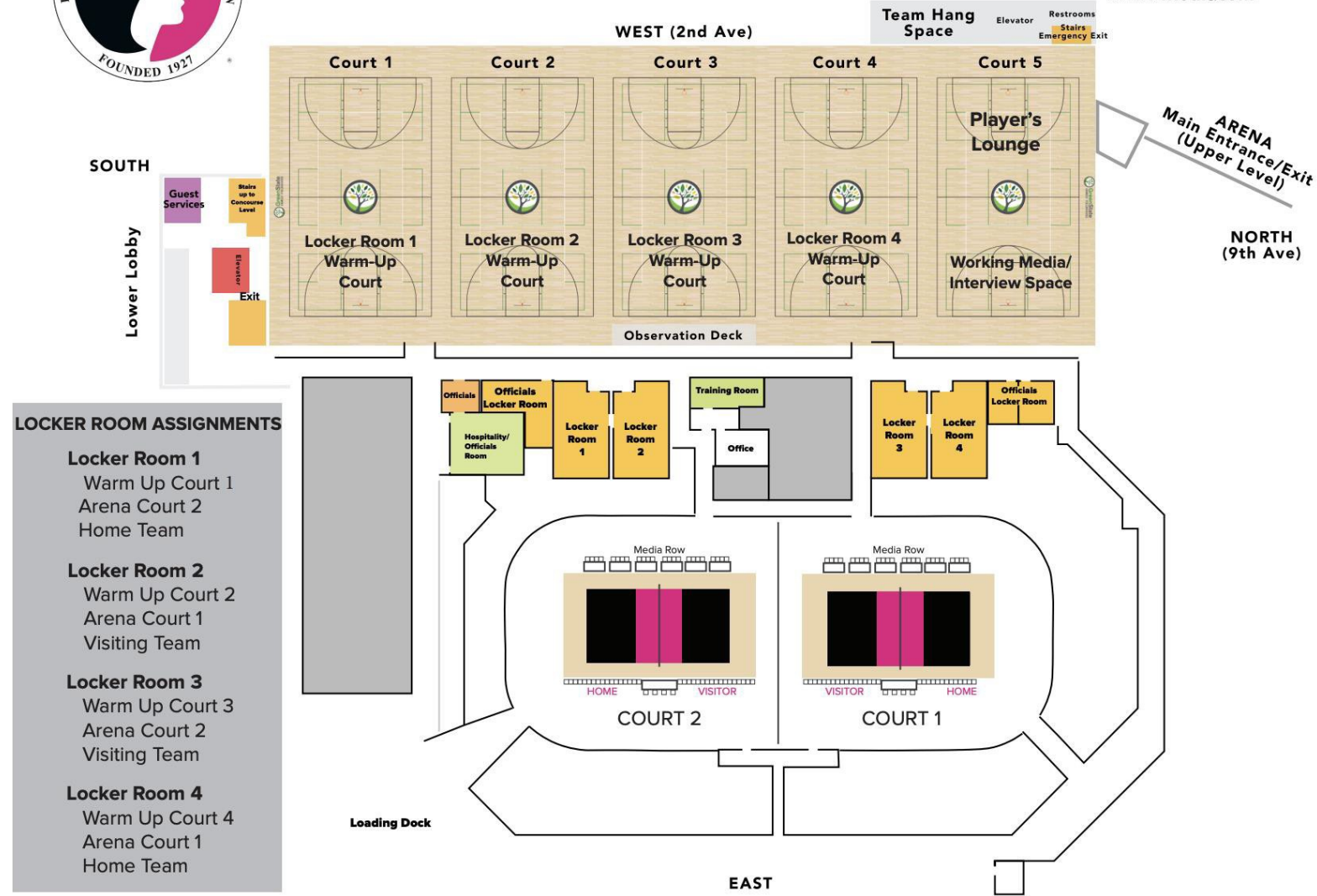
# Practice Courts

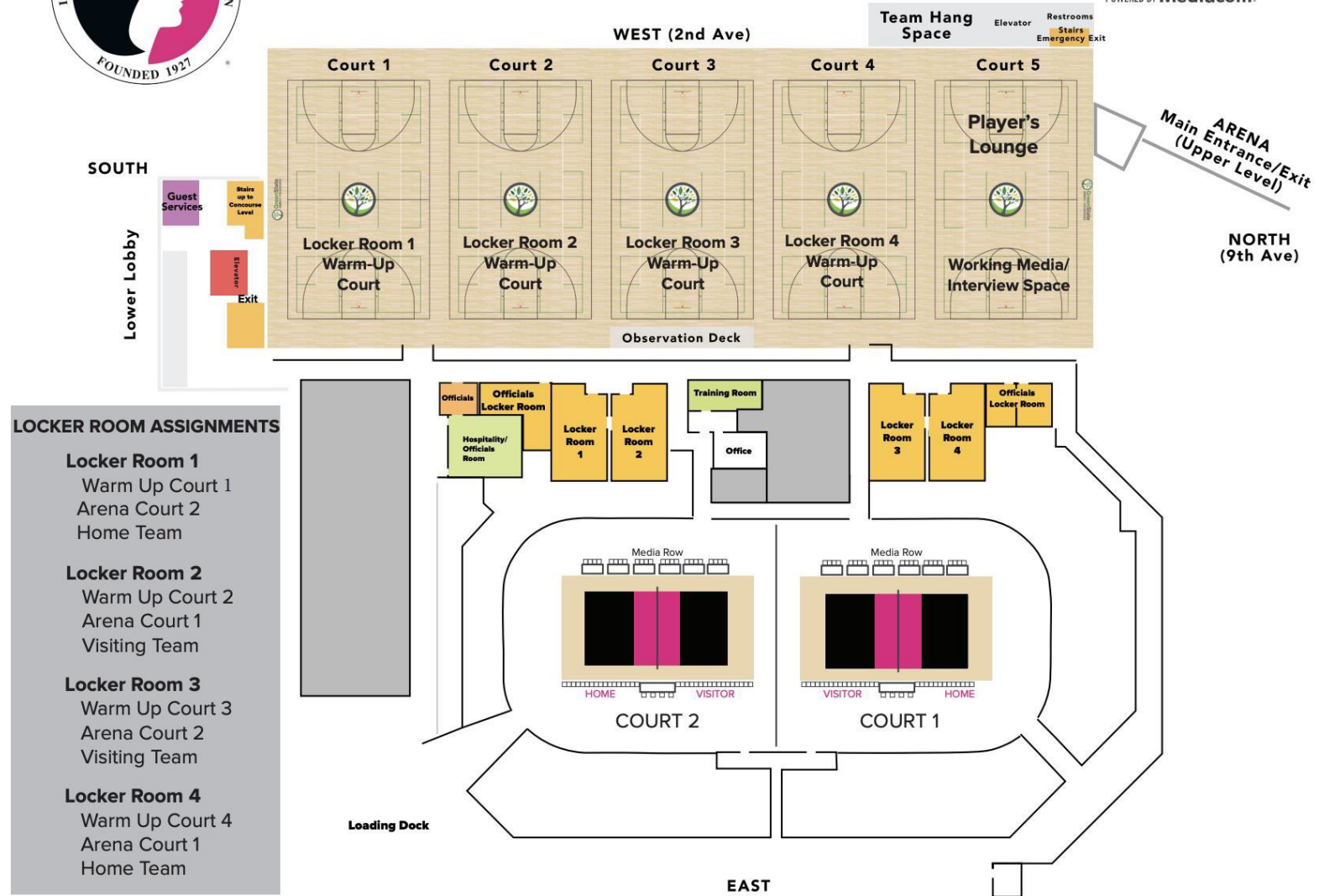


- Volleyballs are provided. Will be at center of your practice court
- **Take your cart of balls with you into Xstream Arena.**
- Stereo systems / audible music stays in the locker room. Not permitted in practice courts.
- Practice court coincides with locker room number.
- Available Sunday night, 4:00 – 9:00 PM, in 1-hour time slots. Priority given to Monday's teams.
- Available Monday night, 6:00 – 9:00 PM, in 1-hour time slots. Priority given to Tuesday's teams.

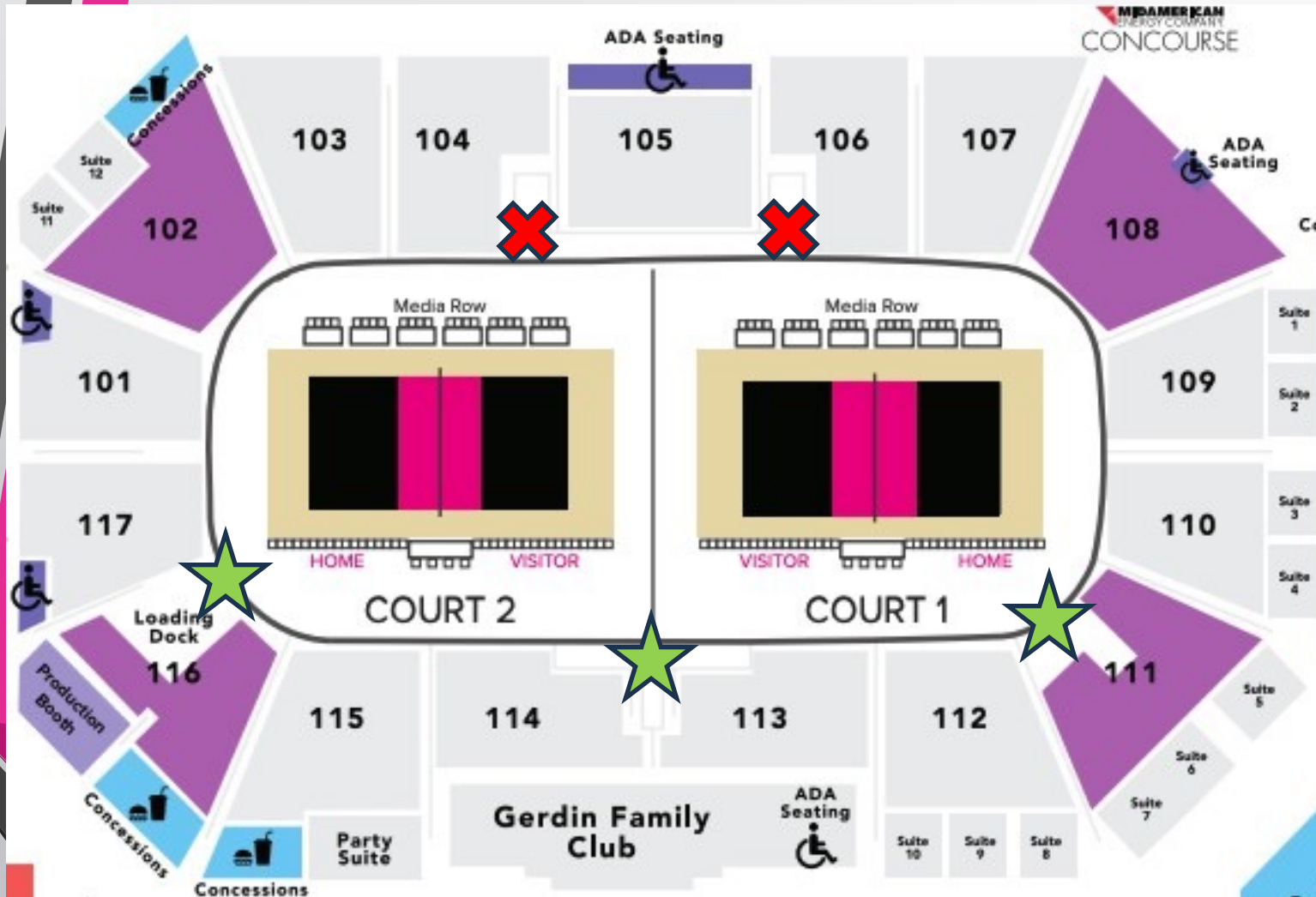

- Local radio interviews can be done before going to the media space.



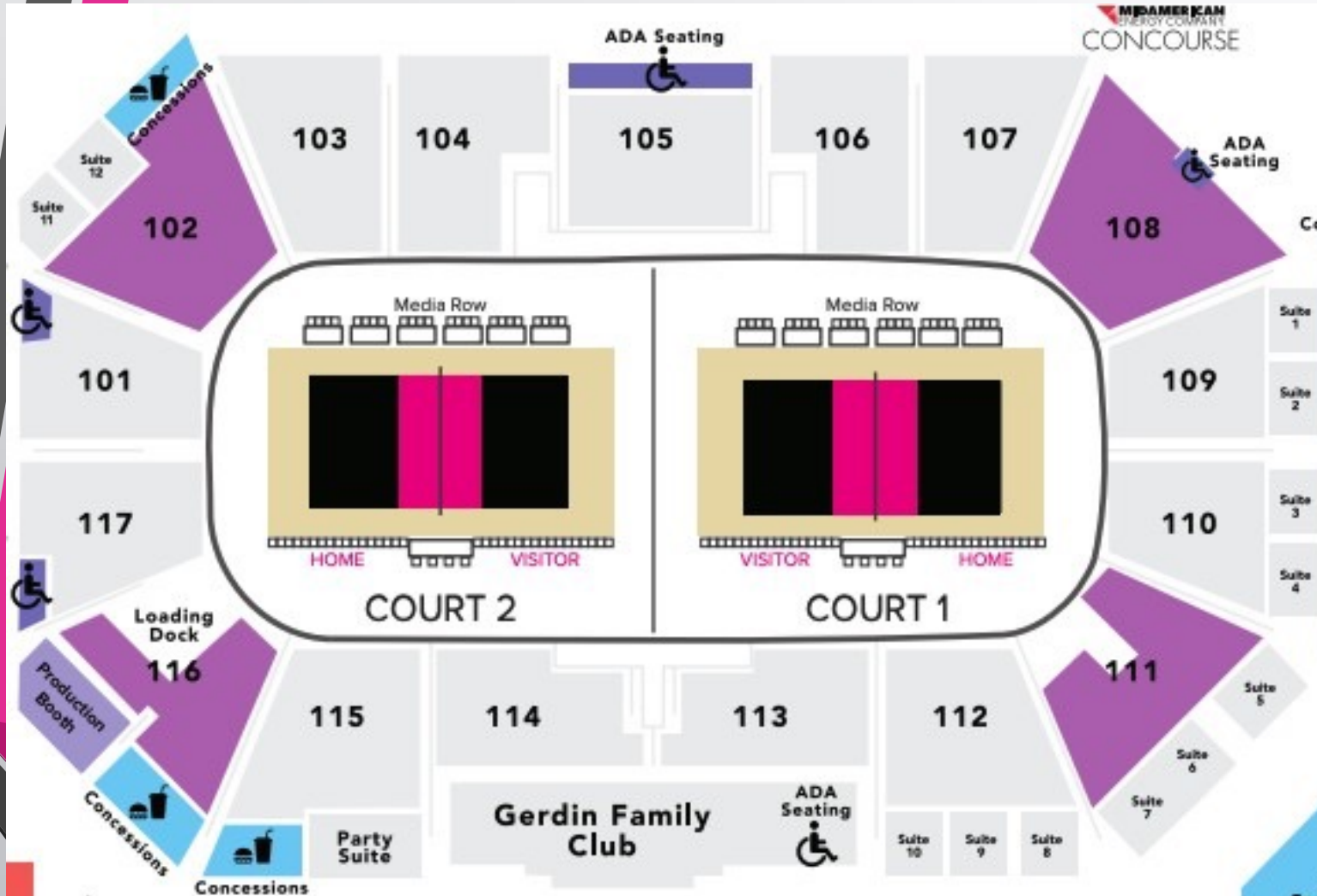
# Team Seating / Arena Set-Up

## Locker Room Hallway



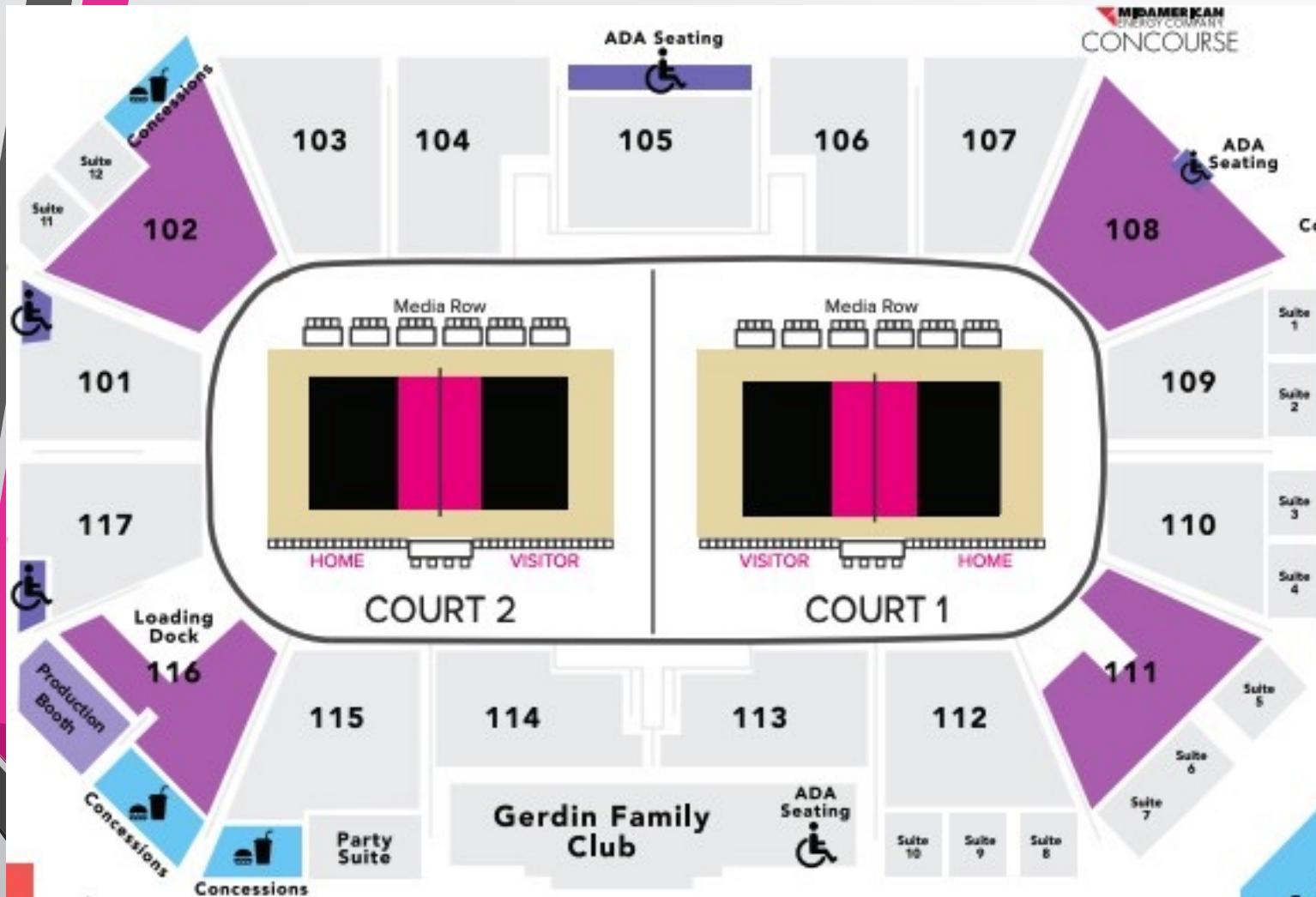
- Pre-match coin flip – “Arena Entrance” sign by 111 & 116
  - Captain & Head Coach
  - 35 min before start of the match.
  - Used to determine first serve.
  - Visiting team (lowest seed) calls flip.
  - Highest (best) seeded team is home team.
- Court 1 will enter through 111
- Court 2 will enter through 116
- DO NOT USE HALLWAYS BY 104 and 106 – to either enter the court or exit between sets
- Between sets: Visitors may exit to east hallway between 113/114. Home may exit through 111, 116

# Team Seating / Arena Set-Up



- Team Benches (10 chairs)
- No more than 23 in the bench area. Extras will be moved to the seats behind the bench if you have more than 23.
- Players standing at the end of the bench should be off the court. The whole court is considered playable area.
- Teams will not change benches. They are set according to spectator locations.

# Team Seating / Arena Set-Up



- **Introductions – endlines.**
  - Starting farthest from the bench:
  - Reserves (low # to high)
  - Assistant Coaches
  - Starters (low # to high) / Libero
  - Head Coach
- **Pre-Match Handshake**
  - Signaled by R1 after intros
- **Non-Playing Team Seating**
  - Court 1 – 2 rows of chairs in front of Sections 106, 107 (behind media rows)
  - Court 2 – 2 rows of chairs in front of 103, 104 + \*\*front of 101, 117\*\*

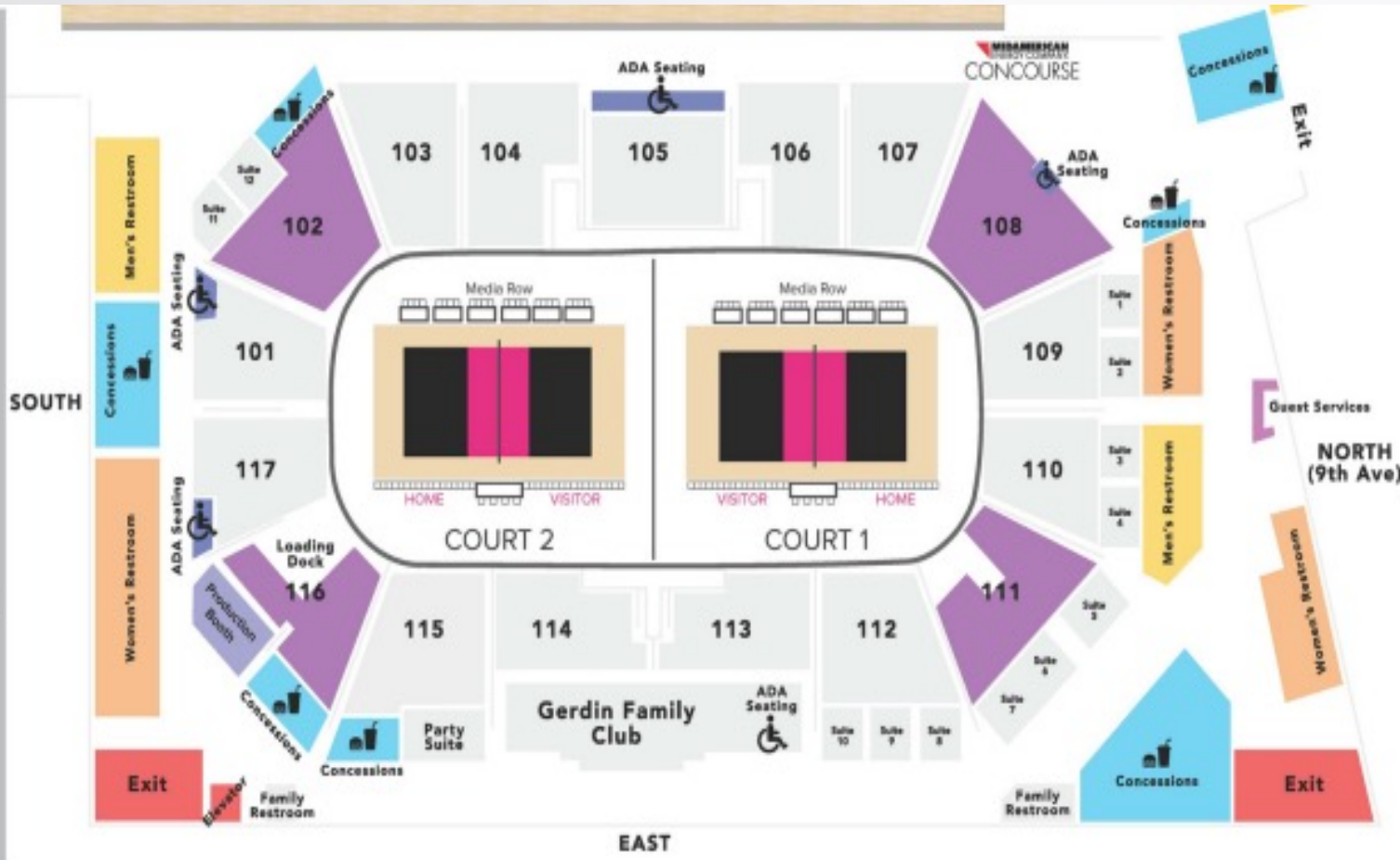

- Home team crowds are behind team benches
- Visiting team crowds are opposite team benches
- Student Sections

# Championship Thursday

- Home Spectators - behind the team benches. Students = 112-113
- Visitor Spectators – opposite the team benches. Students = 103-104
- Coaches will get a specific timing sheet for that day
- Introductions – both teams will enter court through loading dock area (116)
- Fareway Serving Contest – between sets 1 + 2
- Winner's Circle – south side end of arena (101 / 117)
  - ADs assist with floor access @ 102/103
- Award Recognitions
  - Before 2A – Distinguished Coach Award
  - Before 1A – Hall of Fame

# Video Taping / Videographers / Pictures

- Each team is allowed one person to video the match that your team is participating in
- If person is NOT part of the 23-person party, they must purchase a ticket and exchange it at Media Entrance for a credential
- All equipment must run on battery power. **Video cameras must be attended at all times.**
- Filming may take place behind media row or at end line (not by curtain)
- Student Publications – must be a student. Must purchase a ticket & exchange it for media credential @ Media Pass gate. ONE PASS PER SCHOOL per date. Request should have been made already.

# Trainers

- School trainer may sit on the bench if member of the 23-person roster.
- If not member of the 23, still enter through GSFH. Sit on the seats behind team bench.
- ATC provided by the University of Iowa.
- Training Room in the middle of the locker room hallway, b/w locker rooms 2 & 3
- On Court – will be seated between the two courts by the curtain.
- Will be there one hour prior to the first match of the day, through the day.
- There to tape / ice / evaluate. No access to modalities (STEM, etc.)
- Specialty tapes (KT) - must bring your own. ATCs can apply it.

# Television and Web Streaming

- Quarterfinal and semifinal games will be streamed live by CISN TV for the IGHSAU Digital Network. Links will be posted at the top of the IGHSAU website.
- Iowa PBS will televise the championship games.
- Coaches will be mic'd in the championship games.

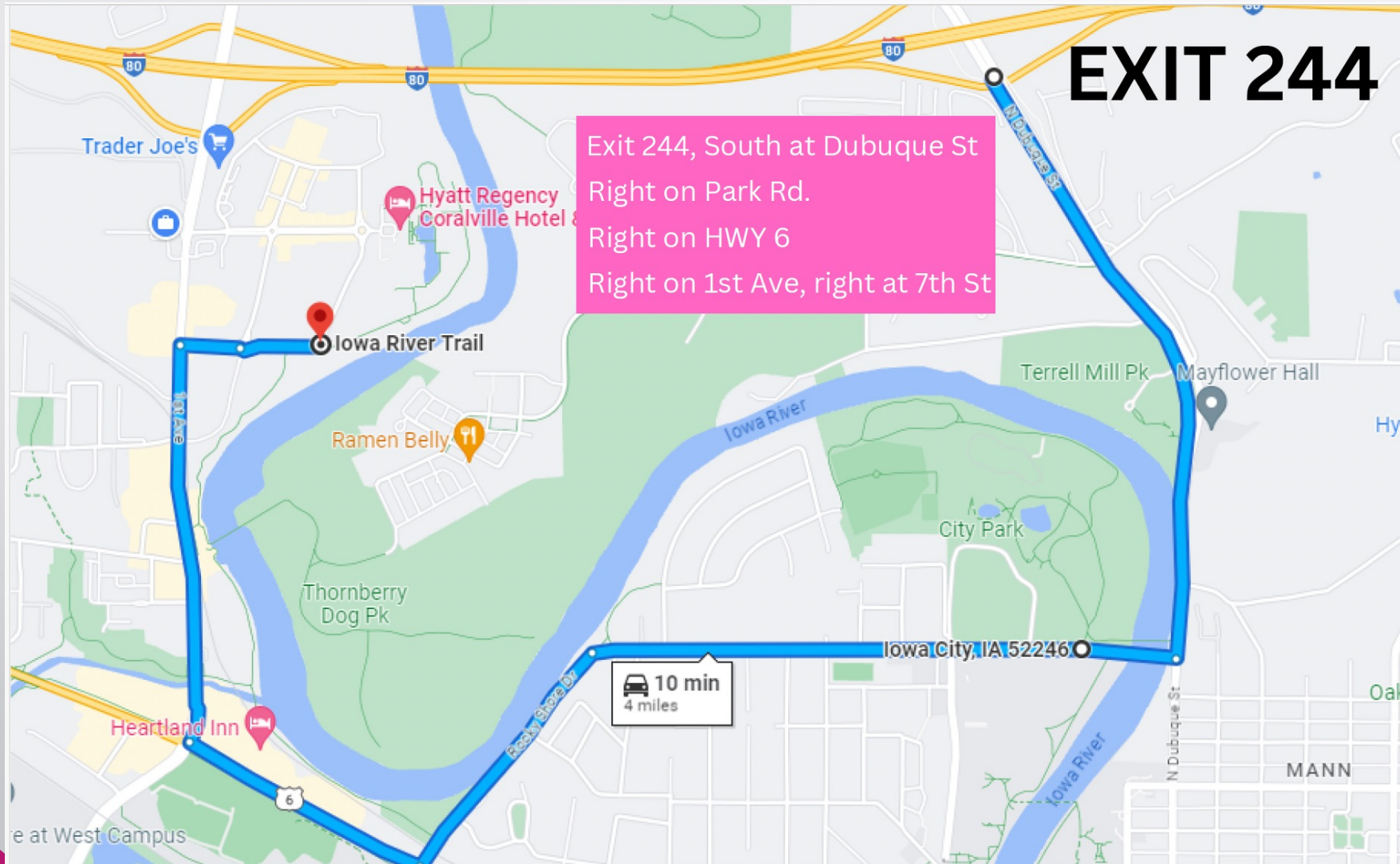

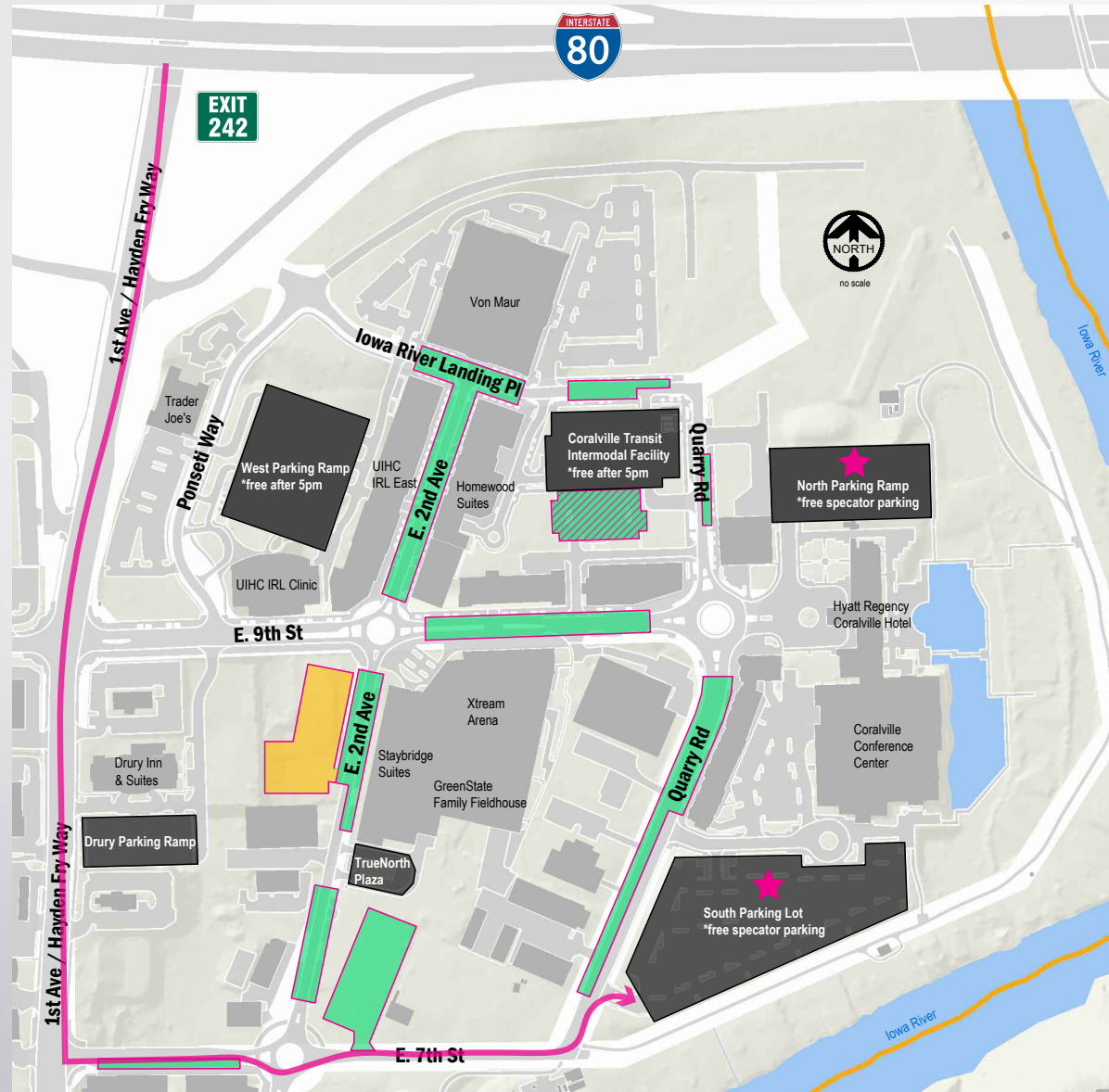

## PARKING MAP

All parking facility availability is subject to change

### PARKING LOTS & RAMPS

#### Coralville Transit Intermodal Facility

Top Level (access from west alley): Homewood Suites and Retail Only; 4-hour parking without permit

Lower Two Levels (access from Iowa River Landing PI or Quarry Rd): Park & Ride and Special Events Only

#### North Parking Ramp

Free spectator parking

#### South Parking Lot

Free spectator parking

#### West Parking Ramp

Levels 1-3 (access from Ponseti Way): UIHC Iowa River Landing Staff & Visitors Only until 5pm

Ground Level (access from east alley): Retail only; 4-hour parking without permit
