Parking

- TEAM TRANSPORTATION –it is highly recommended that all teams are into the park no later than 11 am due to high volume of spectator traffic. **NEW THIS YEAR – all school vans, vehicles and buses will be parking in the campground. There will be a drop off zone in front of the Heun Shelter as in past. We will be utilizing the interior parking area for assessable parking only. Please tell your drivers that all student-athlete pick must be done in designated areas not along the road. This is crucial in maintaining traffic flow out of the park after the meet. Your cooperation in this is greatly appreciated!!**
- Please be aware to schedule enough time to get to the event by expecting traffic delays for both teams and spectators.
- All southbound traffic will be directed into the lot just north of Kennedy Park entrance for parking so cars will have an easy shot out going north after the event. Those needing assessable parking will be allowed into the park. If you miss the north entrance you will be directed to turn back and park in this lot.
- Any cars entering the park before 9 am will be allowed to park anywhere they desire. After 9 am cars will be directed to parking spots.
- From 8 am to 11:30 there will be two lane traffic allowed to enter into Kennedy Park.
- Beginning at 11:30 am to 2:30 pm there will one lane in and one lane out.
- Starting at 2:30 pm until park is cleared will be two lanes out with the north lane designated to make a left turn north and the south lane designated to make a right turn heading south.
- Parking is \$10 per vehicle.
- All assessable parking will be in the clubhouse parking area. All vehicles requesting assessable parking must have proper identification.
- Hospitality vehicles are available for those needing assistance. Please check with a parking attendant.
- There is plenty of parking **INSIDE** Kennedy Park. While there are farm fields adjacent to the venue who park cars – please park inside for a shorter and safer walk to the event.
- There is no roadside parking. All cars parked on the roads will be towed.

Participation Safety

- If any runner happens to go down and need medical attention – please do not remove the student-athlete from the area. Notify a course marshal. There is a trainer on the course as well as several medical professionals ready at the staging area at the finish line.
- No pets allowed on the course.
